The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Governing Body. He said that our college has completed 26 years and the University Grants Commission has granted an autonomous status to our college during the academic year 2004-2005. In these Nine years of Autonomy, our College has introduced lot of innovation not only in the curriculum but also in the examinations which are highly appreciated by the academicians throughout the country. In the academic year 2012-2013, the UGC has sponsored Two Major Projects by the Management Sciences Department and Six Minor Projects are being carried out by the Departments of Catering Science and Hotel Management, Commerce, Computer Science and Electronics. He expressed his hope and expectation that, in future also the college will get more funded projects from UGC. Two MOU's were signed – One by the Department of Catering Science and Hotel Management and Vivanta by Taj- Surya, and an other by the Department of Commerce with the Institute of Cost Accountants of India, Coimbatore Chapter to conduct classes for the Foundation Course at our college.

At the beginning of the academic year 2012– 2013, the college is in the 26th year of its inception with twelve Under-graduate programme , eleven Post-graduate programme, one PG Diploma Programme, M. Phil. in fifteen disciplines and Ph.D. in eight disciplines.

The nine years of autonomous status brought fruitful results in administration, academics and examination system. Our examiners and question paper setters are experts from nationally reputed Institutions of higher learning.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES
